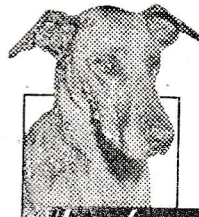

THE ARMY BENEVOLENT FUND.

The Army Benevolent Fund was formed in 1945. Its role is to support financially the benevolent Work of Regimental and Corps Associations and those National Charitable Organisations who care for the need of the Soldier and his dependants.

Since its formation £4,500,000 have been distributed to organisations such as SSAFA, the British Legion, Forces Help Society, Regular Forces Employment Association and others that are concerned with the training and care of the disabled, the aged and the sick, together with the education of children.

Due to dwindling income these grants have now to be reduced drastically. £750,000 is needed annually to continue the work.

From the 6th. to 15th. July many events are to be held to raise funds for the Fund including a Combined Military Bands concert, (this Theatre, 9 p.m. 7th. July) an Open Day at Templer Barracks (2.30 p.m. 7th. July) an Observation Motor Rally (2.30 — 4.30 p.m. 8th. July) Association and Rugby Football Matches, the ever popular Army Horse show at Mitchell Park (13th. — 15th. July) where there will be a Floodlight Tattoo, and in September there is to be boxing between the Army (E. A) and Kenya A. B. A.

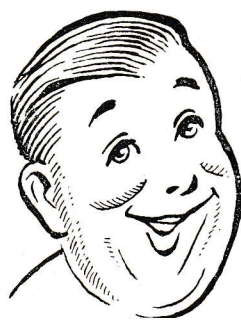

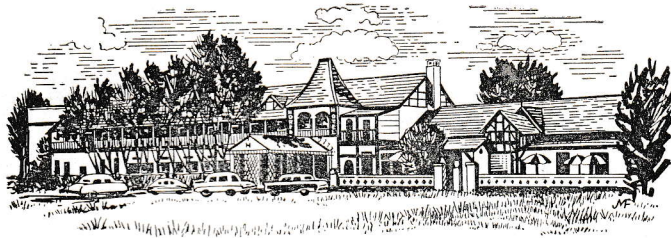

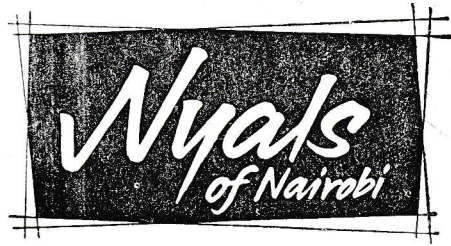
