

THE ARMY BENEVOLENT FUND.

The Army Benevolent Fund was formed in 1945. It's role is to support financially the benevolent Work of Regimental and Corps Associations and those National Charitable Organisations who care for the need of the Soldier and his dependants.

Since it's formation £4,500,000 have been distributed to organisations such as SSAFA, the British Legion, Forces Help Society, Regular Forces Employment Association and others that are concerned with the training are care of the disabled, the aged and the sick, together with the education of children.

Due to dwindling income these grants have now to be reduced drastically. £750,000 is needed annually to continue the work.

July) where there will be a Floodlight Tattoo, and in September there is to be boxing between the Army (E. A) and Kenya A. B. A.


