Although the number of plays written by Arthur Miller is small he has established himself as a major dramatic writer. Two points distinguish him from most other contemporary dramatists — the form and shape of his plays which are largely traditional in structure with a beginning, middle and end which seems slightly old fashioned in a post Godot era, and his belief in social values and the obligations placed upon human beings as members of society.

In 'A View from the Bridge' the society is a Sicilian-American one, of fine loyalties and unforgiving vengeance on anyone who breaks the code. It is a tragedy in the classical sense because the hero. Eddie, is driven by forces beyond his control or understanding into conflict with the 'mores' of his own society. His last question "Why?" expresses the bewilder-ment of a man who suddenly, for no apparent reason, "has a destine" destiny'


